1st Reading: Rv 11:19A; 12:1-6A, 10AB Reader: A reading from the Book of Revelation

God's temple in heaven was opened, and the ark of his covenant could be seen in the temple.

A great sign appeared in the sky, a woman clothed with the sun,

with the moon under her feet.

and on her head a crown of twelve stars. She was with child and wailed aloud in pain as she labored to give birth.

Christ has been raised from the dead, the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep. For since death came through man, the resurrection of the dead came also through man.

For just as in Adam all die, so too in Christ shall all be brought to life, but each one in proper order:

Christ the firstfruits;

then, at his coming, those who belong to Christ;

then comes the end.

when he hands over the Kingdom to his God and Father,

when he has destroyed every sovereignty and every authority and power.

For he must reign until he has put all his enemies under his feet.
