1st Reading: JER 31:7-9

Reader: A reading from the Book of Jeremiah

Thus says the LORD: Shout with joy for Jacob, exult at the head of the nations; proclaim your praise and say: The LORD has delivered his people. the remnant of Israel. Behold, I will bring them back from the land of the north; I will gather them from the ends of the world. with the blind and the lame in their midst, the mothers and those with child; they shall return as an immense throng. They departed in tears. but I will console them and guide them; I will lead them to brooks of water, on a level road, so that none shall stumble. For I am a father to Israel. Ephraim is my first-born.

Reader: The word of the Lord.

All: Thanks be to God.

Brothers and sisters:

Every high priest is taken from among men and made their representative before God, to offer gifts and sacrifices for sins. He is able to deal patiently with the ignorant and erring, for he himself is beset by weakness and so, for this reason, must make sin offerings for himself as well as for the people. No one takes this honor upon himself but only when called by God, just as Aaron was. In the same way, it was not Christ who glorified himself in becoming high priest, but rather the one who said to him: You are my son:

The blind man replied to him, "Master, I want to see."

Jesus told him,

"Go your way; your faith has saved you." Immediately he received his sight and followed him on the way.
